Subsidence lesson: Other Joshimaths in the offing

The Joshimath crisis has exploded with the onset of a new year. Even as a team from the Prime Minister's Office (PMO) takes stock of the very ground whose subsidence has triggered a seismic wave of panic in the Himalayan region—almost foreboding a catastrophe lying in wait—there are two lessons to be learned. First, never ignore the past. Forty-six years ago, a report by an 18-member panel headed by the former collector of Garhwal, M C Mishra, had flagged the problem and suggested the way forward was to go slow on development. The past has come back to bite because successive governments paid no heed. Second, sweeping facts under the carpet is not how an environmental emergency of such proportions must be dealt with. The National Disaster Management Authority's gag order after the National Remote Sensing Centre-ISRO data suggested the land in Joshimath had sunk 5.4 cm in just 12 days will not reverse the damage. The government must remember that only scientific facts can present a solution for the crisis, which is not Uttarakhand's alone. Another aspect that must be borne in mind is groundwater overexploitation, which eventually leads to land subsidence. Interestingly, even the National Capital Region is prone to such dangers because the growing population and rapid urbanisation have driven faster groundwater extraction, eventually causing subsidence. Such patterns have been found elsewhere in the world too. Across the Himalayan region, spanning about 2,500 km from Kashmir to the farthest end of the North East, the current crisis' tremors are being felt as reports of sinking land across northern Indian states are finding their way faster than ever. Chances are much of it will be allowed to be forgotten to calm the nerves, which must not happen. It is also the region where the tectonic plates are always moving, making it vulnerable to seismic activities. The crisis clearly needs a bigger national response. Because, unmindful of the dangers, the entire Himalayan landscape, over the decades, has witnessed unbridled development riding on the demands for tourism, infrastructure and strategic concerns given the geopolitical significance.

When will the mystery of Amelia Earhart's death be solved?



It belongs to 1937. The world's aviation industry had barely learned to run. Adventurers were setting new records with powerful planes of the time. In such dire times, a woman was venturing to set the record of circumnavigating the earth by a single-handed plane. On her adventure, she came near Holland Island in the Pacific Ocean, the female adventurer loses contact with the plane. The plane crashes and is lost in the Pacific Ocean. Efforts are being made to search for this woman continuously for 7 days. The vast expanse of the ocean, which is said to be two and a half million square miles, beckons explorers. However, there is no trace of the woman. Experts believe that the plane ran out of fuel and crashed into the sea. This woman is the female adventurer who will be immortalized in the pages of history - 'Amelia Earhart'. Amelia Earhart's death is considered one of the most mysterious events of the 20th century. Experts are giving different theories regarding his death. Some recent evidence, rather than unraveling the mystery of Amelia Earhart's death, is deepening the mystery. Now, with the new key evidence that has been found, it seems that they may be one step closer to solving the mystery. Who was this woman 'Amelia Earhart'? When will the mystery of his death be solved?

Amelia Earhart was a noted female pioneer in aviation, who became a widely known international celebrity during his lifetime. Because of her achievement, over a thousand women joined the Air Force service during World War II. Whose inspiration was Amelia Earhart. Amelia Earhart was born on July 24, 1897 in Atchison, Kansas. Earhart's father was a railroad lawyer. His mother came from a wealthy family. Earhart exhibited an adventurous nature from the time she was a child. In 1916, he completed his high school education in

Chicago. An inheritance from her mother enabled her to receive a college education at the Ogontz School in Rydal, Pennsylvania. She married an American publisher, writer and researcher, George P. Hapgood with Putnam. At the age of 34, she became the first woman in the world to fly solo across the Atlantic Ocean. "His desire was to emulate the famous solo flight of Charles Lindbergh. He intended to fly to Paris in his single engine Lockheed Vega V plane. But during the flight, after 14 hours of flight, they had to face strong wind storm for 56 minutes. Also, in this situation, mechanical problems also arose in his plane. Due to this, he was forced to cut short the flight and land in a pasture at Culmore in New Ireland. Five years later, she took up the challenge of becoming the first woman to circumnavigate the globe. Earhart was flying a Lockheed Model 10 Electra when his plane disappeared into the ocean on July 2, 1937. According to a popular theory, Amelia Earhart died while landing on a remote coral atoll in the western Pacific Ocean. Decades after her death, Earhart was inducted into the National Aviation Hall of Fame in 1968 and the National Women's Hall of Fame in 1973. When Amelia Earhart visited her sister in Canada, she saw wounded soldiers from the First World War. Because of this, she dropped out of junior college in 1918 to become a nurse. He flew an airplane for the first time in 1920. During which he studied aviation subjects. In 1921, he bought his first plane, a Kinner Airster. Two years later he got his pilot's license. At that time, aviation sponsors were looking for a woman who could cross the Atlantic Ocean. He was selected for this venture in the month of April 1928. Many suspect that one of the reasons for his selection was his resemblance to Charles Lindbergh. Charles Lindbergh was the first man to cross the Atlantic Ocean on



Sharia law came into effect in Afghanistan after these Islamic orthodoxes took over the country from the Soviets in 1992. After the Americans were also driven away, the leaders of the Taliban got a free ground to act as they pleased. After 21 years, Sharia law has been implemented again. It was announced that the Taliban government had implemented Sharia law as a major breakthrough. The Taliban has also asked the judges to apply Sharia law in all the courts of Afghanistan and to give

punishment accordingly. So now Afghanistan will be punished according to Sharia law which is considered extremely cruel. "Sharia law provides for extremely cruel or brutal punishments such as stoning, flogging, public hanging, amputation of hands and feet of thieves. The Taliban claimed when they came to power that they would change themselves, but they did not and gradually pushed Afghanistan towards fundamentalism. "The Taliban began their brutality by taking away women's rights, first by

shutting down women's education, recently banning women from going to gyms and parks. Also, women are prohibited from going out without men. Wearing the veil in public has been ordered. Recently, the Taliban held a meeting with the judges, which included top Taliban leader Haibatullah Akhundzada. "Since last January, the Taliban government has again started taking brutal measures in the name of Sharia. In addition to Kabul and other cities, cloth shops in Herat province have been ordered to destroy clothed mannequins. "The Taliban have justified their move by calling the act of keeping mannequins in cloth shops against Sharia. Not only this but the Taliban administration has also banned the playing of music in vehicles. The Directorate of Promotion of Virtue and Prevention of Vice (DPPV) has passed this order. Shopkeepers in Herat province are devastated by the order and say the statue is their only property. He has paid 100 to 200 dollars for this mannequin. Earlier DPPV had also advised taxi drivers not to pick up women who are not wearing hijab. The Taliban has continued to take repressive measures against women and the condition of women has worsened since the Taliban came to power. They are also prohibited from traveling more than 72 km without a male companion. It is worth mentioning that after the formation of the Taliban government, he promised to reform the country, but now contrary steps are being taken. These laws are the religious laws of Muslims. Which is not fully applied to women in many countries including Saudi Arabia, Pakistan, India, Malaysia, America, Britain, France. If implemented, a complete ban on women's work, women's economic, social, cultural and political life, but a woman lawyer named Bisma Jahangir

Women 'slaves' in 'free' Afghanistan

or Benazir Bhutto was a pioneer in political life in Pakistan. Even in India, sisters like Najma Heptulla, Shabana Azmi are active in politics, but in Afghanistan, the Taliban consider women to be boys and do housework. "After the Taliban came to power in Afghanistan, many strict rules were imposed on women, including not getting education. Due to which women are facing great difficulty in getting education. However, now the independent minded citizens of Afghanistan have started getting education in their own way. For which many secret schools have been opened. Books are kept hidden in the house. A few months ago, the Taliban banned women from going out in public without male escort. While girls are also banned from going to school. Due to these rules of the Taliban, the youth of Afghanistan are focusing on educating themselves in the way to keep pace with the present times. Also, secret schools are now being opened by organizations connected with social service. Courses are now being run in secret as the Taliban monitor those who break their rules to enforce them. "Some girls keep books in the kitchen hidden from the men of the house which they read while cooking. A girl named Nafesa, who is studying secretly, told the media that my brother beats me if he sees a book in my hand. So I decided to keep this book in the kitchen and read it. Since the Taliban has banned girls' education, the situation of women and girls has become dire. In Afghanistan, many

girls and women like Nafesa are reading with books in the kitchen while many secret schools have also opened. These schools are being run by the Revolutionary Association of Women. "To keep women out of higher education, universities in Kabul have barred wire fences and armed guards. "It is also said that it is strange that all over the world emphasis is placed on teaching girls. Campaigns like Beti Padiao, Beti Bachao are also running in India. While the Afghan Taliban consider women as their property. He uses them as he pleases, beats him and if he even opposes him, he punishes him severely. A ban on girls' university education by the Taliban government in Afghanistan has sparked worldwide protests. At that time, the boys of many universities in Afghanistan also came out of their classes and opposed this decision of the Taliban. "More than 60 professors teaching in different universities have resigned from their posts. Along with this, male students have also come forward in support of their female counterparts. He says that the government should immediately withdraw this decision of the ruling Taliban

in Afghanistan as it discriminates against women. "The Taliban have closed all educational institutions for women and girls' schools. Women cannot work. Any organization, company or person who employs women is threatened and intimidated. "Under the Taliban regime, it is a crime to watch or film a videotape, as well as to watch TV. "The Taliban believe that men become corrupted by hearing women's shrill voices. The matter is not so urgent. Women cannot wear sandals or slippers that make noise while walking with high heels. The Taliban believe that even the sound of the heels of the shoes spoils men's minds and for this reason they should not speak loudly or laugh loudly. So this list is very long. "Many girls are brought to the stadium and stoned to death if they do not agree to the wedding organized by their parents. A six-year-old girl was beaten up for carrying school books in public. Two paternal cousins were buried alive because they were conversing in the market. A woman cannot talk to anyone who is not her closest relative, and in this case the Taliban assumed that they were husband and wife.
