Emergency gates constructed overnight in game zones

4 out of 38 in Ahmedabad do not have NOC or BU permission



Ahmedabad
After 28 people were burnt to ashes in Rajkot, the AMC system checked all the game zones in Ahmedabad and found that there are small and big game zones in 38 places. Checking is being done by three different teams designated in this game zone. The Fun Blasts near Chharodi on SG Highway and on Sindhubhan Road have been revealed to be in the secret partnership of former BJP corporator Mahendra Patel and a current BJP corporator. An exit gate was also built overnight in Fun Blast. On the other hand, if Divya Bhaskar's team checked the game zones running in the city even today, it was found that there was no BU permission or fire NOC in two game zones. If a serious accident occurs due to negligence in front of two places, questions arise as to who is responsible.

Corporation was stationed here. They immediately sealed the game zone running without BU permission. When reached here, the municipal corporation officials were waiting for the owner of the game zone. But due to the negligence of the corporation, this game zone was running for some time but the officials were caught sleeping.
Even in Play planet game zone near Vishwas City in Gota, no fire NOC or BU permission was found anywhere. 4 to 5 different types of game were found, but no fire implements of any kind were found. Currently this game zone was closed. However, BU permission has not been taken in this game zone. However, the estate department team of the municipal corporation has no knowledge of this matter.
An entire game zone has been set up in a leaf shed near Seema Hall on the Anandnagar-Prahadnagar road. Fire NOC or any kind of permission was not taken there either. Regarding the game zone, which investigation revealed today, it has been sealed. An attempt has also been made

to cover everything inside with black plastic in this netted game zone erected in a leaf shed.

Notably, Ahmedabad Municipal Corporation has noticed that 34 out of 38 game zones in the city are built in indoor buildings. While the investigation revealed that as many as 6 were made outdoors. BU permission was taken in 34 buildings. BU permission was not taken in 4 buildings. Now questions have been raised about how 4 game zones were started without BU permission. The officials of the Estate Department of the North West Zone of the Municipal Corporation have been caught sleeping on this matter. Police permission has not been taken in some of the 34 game zones.

According to the information received from the sources of the municipal corporation, it has been revealed that there are no rules in each game zone and defects were found in them. Most of the game zones are located. It should have separate entry-exit gates which were not. Also lack of emergency gate was seen. It has been reported that a separate exit gate has been erected overnight in the Fun Blast game zone, which is run in secret partnership between former BJP corporator Mahendra Patel and current BJP corporator on Sindhubhan Road in the city. It has been learned that the gate was erected on Saturday night immediately and in the morning. However, neither the estate department nor the appointed team has given any clarification in this regard.

Welding sparks engulf 28, CCTV The fire at 5:30 on Saturday started the death spree within 5 minutes

CCTV of TRP game zone fire incident in Rajkot has surfaced. A fire broke out while welding inside. As the sparks trickled down, the fire gradually took on a monstrous form. Despite efforts to douse the fire with fire extinguishers, the fire was not extinguished. CCTV has revealed that the fire, which started as a spark, took a ferocious form.

There was a fire rush in the TRP game zone where welding of the shed was going on. Welding was going on upstairs in the shed. Meanwhile on Saturday (25th May) at 5:33 am sparks started falling. The fire grew slowly and within 5 minutes had assumed a ferocious form. In the meantime, the fire has taken a ferocious form and due to the fire, black smoke is starting to appear.

Family members are still searching for the decision to demolish the shed to put out the fire. After extinguishing the fire at 9 pm, it was decided to demolish the shed. For this the JCB was switched on and as its shovel reached the second floor and broke the sheet, the outside air entered and the fire broke out again. Fire tankers were on the spot so the fire was extinguished again. Various reasons are emerging as to the initial stage as to the cause of the fire. The fire brigade and

police officials, who arrived at the scene first, informed that the blast occurred while welding on the stairs and within a minute the fire spread up to the third floor. The game zone had rubber-racin flooring. Approximately 2500 liters of diesel was stored. Over a thousand tires lying around in the car zone when the fire broke out due to a thermocool sheet partition in the iron and sheet structure, spread up to the third floor with an explosion within a matter of minutes and the people inside including children had no chance to get out. When the fire broke out, many people shouted for help from the second and third floors.

28 people were burnt to death in the horrific fire that broke out in the game zone. After the incident, the CM, PM and others tweeted and expressed their grief. However, after the fire on Saturday night, CM Bhupendra Patel and Home Minister Harsh Sanghvi visited the scene on May 25 at 9 am. After that he visited the hospital. He talked to the patients who have suffered burns and asked for information. Also consoled the family of the deceased.

In the Gozari tragedy of Rajkot's game zone, a crime has been registered against six accused including Yuvraj Singh, Prakash Jain in Taluka Police Station.

Over 100 game zones closed after Rajkot tragedy, 30% did not have fire NOC

Rajkot, After the fire incident in Rajkot's TRP game zone, checking was conducted in all the game zones running across the state on Sunday. During the investigation, more than 100 game zones in the state have been closed for non-compliance. Out of which more than 30 percent (GameZone) did not have fire NOC at all. Some were operating without permission for 5 years. Most of the game zones have been found to have high levels of fire extinguishers. Apart from this, shocking details have come to light that there is only one door

for entry and exit, and some doors are opening late. 3 Gamezones in Bhuj were sealed for construction going on without permission. So there was only one way to and from the underground game zone in Madhapar. 3 Gamezones were closed in Charotar after running without NOC for 5 years. After the Anand Mela in Palanpur was closed on Saturday night itself, it was found that there are fire safety equipments but no NOC has been obtained. In Ahmedabad, 25 game zones have been registered in government register. Out of

which only 10 game zones currently have fire NOCs, while the remaining game zones are running without fire NOCs. According to the released information, 9 managers have applied for fire NOC in Ahmedabad, but the fire NOC has not been given to the managers by the police station of that area. 3 teams were prepared to inspect the game zone in Ahmedabad on Sunday. After the Rajkot incident, 25 game zones of Ahmedabad were closed. Go karting runs in the basement parking lot of a mall in Vadodra. All 10 game zones in Vadodra have been closed.

Sun-relieving shade broken A luxury bus rammed into a shade erected at a traffic signal, a biker injured

Vadodra, A shed erected on the circle near Akota Dandiya Bazar Bridge in Vadodra city collapsed after being hit by a luxury bus. A biker was injured. The whole incident of breaking the shed was captured on CCTV. Due to the sudden collapse of the shed, due to the intense heat falling in the city of Vadodra, the Vadodra city police are erecting green netted sheds to provide shelter to the motorists standing on the traffic signal to get relief from the sun. Among them, a shed was erected near Dandiya Bazar Bridge on Sunday afternoon

itself. This shed near Shani Mandir was destroyed due to a sudden collapse. However, a motorcyclist passing by the spot sustained leg injuries and his two children and wife were rescued. Bhai More, a 40-year-old retiree living at Yoginagar in Vadodra's Gori area, was on his way home on a bike with his wife and children. At around 11:00 pm, the luxury bus got stuck in the carrier shed. So the shade erected on the iron angle with green curtain suddenly collapsed. The biker driver, a retired brother, sustained injuries on

his right leg when the shed collapsed. He expressed his outrage to the system that due to the negligence of the system, it would have been the turn of my wife or child to lose his life. Traffic was diverted after the shed collapsed. It is mentioned that green net sheds are being prepared on different circles by the Vadodra Police to provide relief to the motorists from the heat at traffic signals. This operation has been started from Friday and these sheds are being prepared on different circles every day.

Chain-sneater of man who broke gold thread in Gandhinagar sent to Rajkot jail under penalty

Ridha chain breaker, who broke the gold thread and created havoc in the area of 27 Mansa and Sector-21 police station of Gandhinagar district, has been detained under the LCBA aspect and sent to Rajkot Central Jail following the order of the District Magistrate.

Gandhinagar Range IG Virendrasinh Yadav and District Superintendent of Police Ravi Teja Vasamsetty gave the necessary instructions to the subordinate officers to propose the aspect of criminal activity in Gandhinagar district regarding the general election of the Lok Sabha. According to which the LCB PDB wala cast the horoscope of the people who committed serious crimes in the district.

It came to light that four cases of chain snatching were registered against Sagar alias Techio Dashrathi Nathaji Thakor of Lakardora village, Mansana in the year - 2022/ 2024 in Mansana and Sector-



21 police station limits. Following which, under the guidance of PI Wala, ASI Virbhadransinh Laxmansinh Nara prepared a proposal against the chain snapper Sagar and sent it to the District Magistrate for approval.

At that time, the District Magistrate, taking into account the chain snatcher's criminal history, granted the petition and issued an arrest warrant. As soon as the order was received, Sagar Thakor was immediately picked up by the LCB and sent to the Rajkot Central Jail under tight police custody.

Car overturns near Bodeli-Narmada Canal Car plunges into 30-feet deep pit while trying to save bike, family in car rescued

While trying to rescue a bike near the Bodeli-Narmada Canal, the car got stuck in a 30 feet deep ditch. Fortunately, despite the car overturning, there were no casualties. No police complaint has been filed in this regard yet.
